Water Management is of crucial importance for sustained development of agriculture. More and more emphasis is being laid on optimum utilization of available Water resources in this sector. Minor Irrigation schemes benefit a large no. of farmers in helping them to meet their irrigation requirements. Irrigation schemes using either Ground water or Surface water and having a culturable command area of less than 2000 Hectare individually are categorised as Minor Irrigation schemes. The Census of Minor Irrigation schemes provides detailed information up to Tehsil/Village level on number and type of Minor Irrigation schemes 'in use', 'not in use' with reasons thereof, their created potential, extent of utilization, cost of construction of schemes, their financing, share of public sector and that of individual farmer in Minor Irrigation schemes etc.. For effective implementation of policy & Planning, a sound database regarding Minor Irrigation sector is a must.


