Subject: Disposal of remand cases.

In most of the cases where appeals/revisions are accepted and the mutation orders passed by the subordinate Revenue Officers are rejected, the courts invariably remand the cases to subordinate Revenue Officers for passing appropriate orders after holding fresh enquiries but it has been noticed that disposal of these **remand cases** is very poor and no feedback is given to the higher authorities in this respect. It has also been seen that in some cases no action is taken by the lower Officers in respect of these **remand cases** which remain lingering on for years together, even for more than 20 years in some cases.

It is, therefore, impressed upon all Deputy Commissioners/Tehsildars to expedite the disposal of these **remand cases** as per the directions given in the orders of the higher courts and any **remand case** should not take more than **3 months time** for passing appropriate orders after holding denovo enquiries.

The information in respect of these **remand cases** be submitted to this office before **10th of every succeeding month** by all Deputy Commissioners/Tehsildars as per the following proformae:-
