Subject:- Acquisition/Transfer/Allotment of Kahcharie Land.

C I R C U L A R

It has been observed that Deputy Commissioners (District Collectors) are frequently recommending cases for acquisition/transfer/allotment of Kahcharie land instead of State land, which should be first priority.

The Kahcharie land, being in the collective ownership of local community, is reserved for grazing purpose and should be left free for its use for the purpose it has been reserved for. Keeping in view this sprit, the Government has restrained acquisition of Kahcharie lands for any purposes of public utility.

Therefore, it is enjoined upon all the subordinate Revenue Officers not to process cases regarding the allotment or transfer of Kahcharie lands in future. This is in furtherance of the advice received from the Administrative Department vide their No:Rev/S/123/2010 dated:12-08-2010.
